



Dear Parents,

We are delighted to be sending you details of this year's Year 5/6 residential. We will be going to Boggle Hole YHA near Whitby for two nights (leaving Rowsley on Monday 10th June and returning on Wednesday 12th June). Activities include: a visit to Whitby Surf School - where the children will learn to surf; coastal walks; rock-pooling; and several trips to the beach for rounders, games and campfires. Mrs Hewitt and myself will lead this residential along with Mrs. Booker. Surfing will be led by trained surf instructors.

Please note that your child will need a packed lunch for the first day - no fizzy drinks or glass bottles, please. If you would like your child to bring some spending money, there will be opportunities to buy things in Robin Hood's Bay (we would recommend no more than £10).

Also a reminder that the trip should be paid in full no later than Monday 3rd June.

4.30pm - Arrive in Rowsley (we will keep you up to date on our journey via Parent Hub)


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Kit List

- Large rucksack/holdall (avoid wheeled suitcases if possible).
- Pyjamas
- Swimwear (to be worn under wetsuits whilst surfing)
- Shoes (to be worn in the sea)
- Hard-wearing trousers (leggings/joggers) and/or shorts (no jeans)
- Base layers/vests/T-shirts
- Warm fleece/ jumpers
- Socks/underwear (we advise bringing 2 pairs of socks for each day)
- Waterproof jacket
- Sturdy shoes or boots, e.g. walking boots, or old trainers for activities.
- Trainers (not plimsolls) for evenings (no sandals / crocs)
- Named water bottle
- Toiletries including toothpaste, toothbrush, roll-on deodorant (no aerosols). All preferably in a named wash-bag.
- Towel
- Torch and spare batteries
- Plastic bag for dirty clothes (black bin bag)
- Sun cream/sun hat
- Packed lunch for the first day
- Book/cards/game (nothing electronic or valuable) to enjoy during down time.
- Camera (optional)
- Bucket and spade (optional)

What not to pack:

- Mobile phones, tablets, electronic games consoles etc.
- Jewellery

Please ensure kit list items are labelled wherever possible. Whilst packing, please keep in mind that clothes and shoes will be worn to undertake physical, outdoor activities – potentially in muddy (or wet, sandy) conditions, so we strongly recommend packing comfortable clothing and footwear that you're happy to get wet and muddy!

We cannot accept liability for the loss of any personal property, so please don't bring any valuable items.

We hope that your child has the most wonderful time whilst they are away with us. We will update our school website and Instagram whilst we are away with pictures from the trip.
