History

Ancient Egypt: Timeline work; what Ancient Egyptians believed about the after-life; why the Rosetta Stone was such a significant find; Ancient Egyptian gods and goddesses; why the Nile was so important to Ancient Egyptians; jobs and everyday life in Ancient Egypt; the tomb of Tutankhamun.



Maths

Multiplication and division: 8 and 11 times tables (Y3), preparing for the statutory Multiplication Tables Check (Y4).

Fractions (Y3 only): Finding unit fractions and non-unit fractions of an amount. Answering word problems relating to fractions of amounts. Adding and subtracting fractions.

Decimals (Y4 only): Compare, order and round decimals. Understand halves and quarters as decimals.

Money: Add and subtract amounts of money to give change, using both £ and p in practical contexts, solve problems involving money.

Science

Forces and Magnets: Compare how things move on different surfaces; notice that some forces need contact between two objects, but magnetic forces can act at a distance; observe how magnets attract or repel each other and attract some materials and not others; compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of whether they are attracted to a magnet, and identify some magnetic materials; describe magnets as having 2 poles; predict whether 2 magnets will attract or repel each other.

Religious Education

Why do some people think that life is a journey? What significant experiences mark this? Suggest why some people see life as a journey and identify some of the key milestones on this journey; describe what happens in Christian, Jewish, and Hindu ceremonies of initiation and commitment and say what these rituals mean; suggest reasons why marking the milestones of life are important to religious people.
