2024 SEND ATTAINMENT

On average SEND pupils made expected or better than expected progress in Reading, Writing, Maths & EGPS, based on our termly Cornerstones assessments.

We also assess children against their IEP targets and track progress in interventions. All children taking part in Toe by Toe, Phonics Catch-Up and Power of 2 made accelerated progress in the corresponding areas of the curriculum.

SEND Key Priorities:

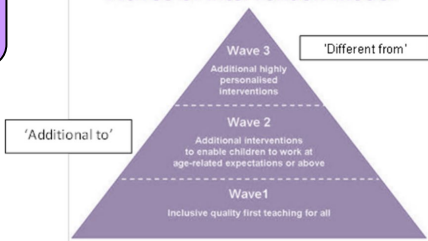
- ❖ Ensure children with SEND are happy in school and feel supported.
